

## College of Business Administration Graduate Programs Admission Requirements

Applicants to one of the College of Business Administration's graduate programs [Master of Business Administration (BADM), Master of Science in Accounting (ACCT), or Master of Science in Project Management (PMGT)] will be required to submit certain documentation. Please see the included comprehensive chart containing each of the programs' requirements.

To be considered for a GMAT waiver based on experience (as applicable per program), email your request for a waiver review to busgrad@shsu.edu. Include your name and the program to which you will be applying within the body of your email and attach your current résumé along with a copy of your transcripts from the degree-granting institution (unofficial transcripts suffice for this review).

If your admission will be considered using one of our formula calculations, please note that the undergraduate GPA is the GPA from courses taken at the degree granting institution. Transfer grades are **not** used in the computation of this undergraduate GPA.

Applicants to each of the programs should note that, without an undergraduate degree in business, certain "stem" or leveling courses may be required prior to beginning any graduate coursework in that program. In some cases, especially for those seeking admission to the Master of Science in Accounting program, this can add considerable hours to the program. Contact the graduate advisor for details.

All students should note that the majority of the graduate-level courses offered in the traditional in-class format are taught at The Woodlands Center campus, SHSU's new facility located in The Woodlands, Texas, 45 miles south of Huntsville, Texas.
