- (2) Select HUMA 1301 topic course Great Questions Seminar; HUMA 1301 cannot be counted twice within the degree plan.
- (3) Or select any course from the American History (060) section of the Core Curriculum Course List; HIST 2301 and HIST 2381 may only be taken once. Students transferring to a four-year institution should contact the college or university advisor for specific course recommendations.
- (4) MATH 1342 or MATH 1332 is recommended. Select any course from the Mathematics (Code 020) section of the Core Curriculum Course List. Students transferring to a four-year institution should contact the college or university advisor for specific course recommendations.
- (5) Select any course from the Life and Physical Sciences (Code 030) section of the Core Curriculum Course List. Students transferring to a four-year institution should contact the college or university advisor for specific course recommendations.
- (6) Or select SPCH 1315, SPCH 1318, or SPCH 1321 at ACC.
- (7) Or select PHIL 1304, PHIL 2306, or PHIL 2307 at ACC.

Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice

- Student must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework.
- 42 semester hours of advanced coursework (3000 or 4000 level) are the absolute minimum. Minimum number of semester hours in residence: 30 semester hours of which 24 must be advanced.
