#### Notes/Comments:

- (1) All first-time Austin Community College (ACC) students with fewer than 12 SCH of successful college credit must take EDUC 1300 in their first semester at ACC. All other students must take COSC 1301. See an advisor or a full-time faculty member in Criminal Justice for more information.
- (2) CRIJ 2361 is required for B.A.A.S. degree and can satisfy both Core Curriculum requirements for Component Area VIII (Social and Behavioral Sciences), and Degree Concentration requirements.
- (3) 36 hours of work-force class will transfer in-block. See SHSU B.A.A.S. Program Coordinator for more details.
- (4) Must be taken in the last semester as the last required Criminal Justice course for AAS.
- (5) Advanced CRIJ Electives 3000 4000 level CRIJ courses

- (7) The total hours reflect the inclusion of two lower-division courses -- CRIJ 2362 and CRIJ 2364 -- in the Criminal Justice Concentration. If the student does not have prior credit for CRIJ 2362 and CRIJ 2364, the total hours increase to 126.

#### **Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences: Criminal Justice Concentration**

- Student must earn a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in all coursework.
- 36 semester hours of advanced coursework (3000 or 4000 level) are the absolute minimum. Minimum number of semester hours in residence: 30 semester hours of which 24 must be advanced.

- Transfer Honors students admitted to SHSU:
  - o will be accepted to SHSU's Honors College. Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 and satisfy other Honors College admission criteria (such as full-time enrollment of at least 12 hours)
  - o may transfer up to 12 hours of transfer Honors credits
  - o will be eligible for additional scholarships
  - o may develop their transfer Honors thesis (if completed) into an SHSU Honors thesis (and thereby graduate "with Highest Honors")
  - will be eligible, if space permits, to live in SHSU's dorms
