**Scholarship Overview:** This scholarship is designed to assist students with the costs of preparing for law school. Such costs include LSAT Prep Books, trips to visit law schools, or the like. The scholarship committee will consider GPA/Academic Performance; membership, professionalism, and activity levels in the Pre-Law Society (PLS); preparedness for the LSAT; ability to engage fully in a summer prep course; hours completed; as well as other factors that relate to a student's potential for attending law school. To be eligible, students must be members of the PLS and have taken the LEAP Center's Mock LSAT on April 5. Depending on the number of students applying, this could include eligibility for a free course taught by Ricky Kaplan, free study materials, or partial/full cost of a commercial course.

**Deadline:** The deadline for the 2025 scholarships is **April 15**. Awards will be announced on or before May 1.
