

Engaging Exploration Workshop

Facilitator Application

There are 3 Engaging Exploration (EE) workshops per year (May-July). By applying to be the facilitator of the EE workshops you will be expected to:

1. Participate as co-facilitator with the previous EE facilitator(s) for one or more workshops in 2025.
2. Remain available to facilitate EE workshops in 2026.
3. Contribute to ongoing EE planning and evaluation, including one or more in-person meetings in Spring/Summer 2025.

In order to be eligible for the facilitator position, an instructor must have completed a previous EE workshop. The course materials for EE and administrative support will be provided by the Director of the TLC. The facilitator is encouraged to suggest revisions and new materials. The facilitator will receive a stipend of \$1000 for each session they co-facilitate and \$2000 for each session they facilitate independently. In subsequent years, EE scheduling may take the facilitator's availability into account.

To apply, please provide a short statement (~2 pages) addressing the questions below and return to the TLC email (tlc@shsu.edu) before 5 pm on January 24th, 2025. After applications are reviewed, applicants may be asked to open their classroom for a visit from the selection committee.

1. What were the most important lessons in your Engaging Exploration training?
2. Explain the importance of active learning to you.
3. Will you be able to commit to at least three EE sessions in 2025-2026?
4. What is your interest in the EE facilitator role?
