## **Moment of Silence Bill**

Date: November 26, 2024

Whereas: The Sam Houston State University Student Government

Association acts as the "Official Voice of the Student Body";

and,

Whereas: The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag and the

Pledge of Allegiance to the Texas flag serve as solemn expressions of respect and patriotism, reflecting the shared values of liberty, democracy, and pride in our country and state;

and,

Whereas: The inclusion of a brief moment of silence following the pledges

allows members of the Senate to reflect on the meaning of the pledges and the responsibilities they bear as student leaders; and,

Whereas: A moment of silence provides an opportunity for introspection,

mindfulness, and a renewed sense of purpose, which can

enhance the quality of deliberation and decision-making within

the Senate; and,

Whereas: The Senate seeks to foster a sense of unity, respect, and civil

engagement among its members; and,

**Therefore:** Immediately following the recitation of both pledges, the

presiding officer of the Senate shall call for a moment of silence. The moment of silence shall last no longer than one minute; and, Therefore:
