Resolution S-25-01

R+L Carriers Bowl Carriers Bowl Champion Recognition

Discussion on the Resolution:

- Senator Balfour inquired about the purpose of the resolution, asking whether it was addressing a problem within SGA. President Scott clarified that resolutions do not always address problems; rather, they can serve to acknowledge and celebrate achievements. In this case, the resolution aims to recognize the university's football team for securing their first-ever bowl game victory.
 - Senator Balfour then questioned the timing of the resolution, noting that the game took place last semester in December. President Scott acknowledged this but explained that due to scheduling constraints, including a delay in internal processes and a missed meeting caused by snow days, the resolution is only now being introduced during the fourth meeting of the semester. To summarize, the resolution's purpose is to officially recognize and support the football team's achievement on behalf of the student body.
 - Parliamentary Brett moved to amend the last whereas "the R+L Bowl to R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl"

- Seconded by Senator Durham
 - Voting 1 abstention

Discussion on the name:

- Senator Moody raised a question regarding potential confusion surrounding the resolution, asking, "Is there any room for confusion on this? Is this a huge deal? Can it be confused with anything else, or does it really matter?" Senator Moody further clarified that they believe the reference to R. and L. Bold is specific enough and understood by everyone. "We're just kind of being a little easier with it, that's all I have to say on that," they concluded.
- Senator Rodriguez expressed strong support for the resolution, stating, "I think, for the season that the football team had, it would be really, really cool to acknowledge them on something like this. Given that the game was back in December, I feel like, you know, it was a really good season, and they went all the way to win the bowl game. So this is something that I fully agree with, that I think we should all take into consideration again." Senator Rodriguez emphasized the importance of school spirit, concluding with, "Eat them up, Kats! Let's show them that spirit."
