Exploring the Impact of Psychological Variables on Return to Sport Post ACL-R

This study aims to compare psychological readiness and kinesiophobia (fear of reinjury) in collegiate athletes who have been cleared to return to sport (RTS) protocol following anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction (ACL-R). Differences can provide insight into the importance of addressing psychological factors beyond RTS. They can allow for interventions that enhance psychological readiness and reduce kinesiophobia, supporting more practical athletic performance outcomes.
