## Sam Houston State University

- **1879**—The Sam Houston Normal Institute is named after Sam Houston and opens its doors on October **10**, **1897**.
- **1880** First graduation day with a class of 37 students graduating.
- **1889** The Main Building is built In later years the building becomes known as "Old Main."
- **1902** Peabody Memorial Library is built.
- **1911** The first football game is played. The name of the school teams at that time was the "Normals". Rice defeats Sam Houston.
- **1913** The first copies of the school newspaper, *"The Houstonian"* are published. The Houstonian was named after Sam Houston.
- **1919** Hulon Anderson is the first to graduate with a B. A. Degree.
- **1923** The name of the school is changed to Sam Houston State Teachers College.
- **1923** The school mascot becomes the BearKat.
- 1923-1933 Sometime between 1923 and 1933, Sam Houston State Teachers College adopts the school colors of orange and white.

- **1929** The first 50 years are celebrated in the SHSTC's Semi-Centennial.
- **1953-55** The SHSTC celebrates 75 years with a two year Diamond Jubilee celebration.
- **1959** A BearKat costumed mascot appears for the first time.
- **1964** The first African-American student, John Patrick, enrolls at Sam Houston State.
- **1965** The name of the school is changed to Sam Houston State College
- **1969** The name of the school is changed once again to Sam Houston State University
- 1979 Sam Houston State University celebrates 100 years of education with a Centennial Celebration.
- **1982** The Old Main Building burns to the ground on February 12, 1982.
- **2004** Sam Houston State University celebrates 125 years
- **2007** The historic name of Sam Houston State University is protected by the Texas Legislature.


### Did you know?

## General Sam Houston: His Amazing Life



Sam Houston was born in Virginia on March 2, 1793. When he was a boy his family moved to Tennessee. After running away from home to live with the Cherokee Indians who called him "The Raven," Sam became a school teacher. During the War of 1812, Sam Houston joined the army and became a military hero, having served with General Andrew Jackson at the Battle of Horseshoe Bend. Houston attained many political positions, even governor of Tennessee.

Sam moved to Texas in the early 1830's and helped Texas gain independence from Mexico. As general of the Texas army, Houston defeated the Mexican dictator Santa Anna at the Battle of San Jacinto in 1836. Now that Texas was independent, Sam was elected president of the Republic of Texas. Texas became the 28th state in the United States in 1845, and Sam was then elected senator. After serving in the senate for over ten years, Houston was elected governor of Texas. Sam passed away in Huntsville on July 26, 1863.

- ξ 1847: moves to Huntsville to build Woodland Home for family
- ξ 1859: elected governor of Texas
